WHAT IS A PATIENT AMBASSADOR?

A Patient Ambassador is a dialysis or predialysis **patient or family member** who **volunteers** to represent DPC by being a leader in their community and local dialysis facility. One of your primary responsibilities will be to provide dialysis patients with the education, access and confidence to be their own advocates.

WHY SHOULD I BE A PATIENT AMBASSADOR?

You can **make a significant difference in the lives of all dialysis patients** by representing DPC and ensuring that your voice and the voices of other predialysis and dialysis patients are heard!

WHAT IS DPC?

With more than 23,000 dialysis and predialysis patients making up our membership, DPC is working to improve the quality of life for all dialysis patients through education and advocacy. We are a nationwide, nonprofit, patientled organization with membership open to all dialysis and predialysis patients and their families. Our policies and our mission are guided solely by our membership.

WHAT THE EXPECTATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF A PATIENT AMBASSADOR?

DPC provides all the training, tools, materials and support you need to:

- **Build a Relationship with your Legislators**
 - Invite your members of Congress and/or district staff to visit your dialysis facility
 - Respond to DPC Action Alerts and distribute them to other patients and families
 - Contact your Members' Washington offices

- Educate Fellow Patients and Members of your Community
 - Distribute articles and other educational materials to the patients in your clinic and be prepared to answer non-medical questions
 - Educate your community on kidney disease
- Recruit new DPC members and mobilize patients to advocate for their care
 - Encourage other patients in your facility and community to join DPC
 - Recruit new Patient Ambassadors

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF BEING A PATIENT AMBASSADOR?

- Recognition as a leader in your community
- Potential to visit Washington, D.C. for Washington D.C. Advocacy Days (all expenses covered by DPC)
